ACCOMODATION INFORMATION

The rooms are set up Dormitory style with a shared bathroom. The men are in a separate section from the women but all the rooms are on the 8th Floor of 50 Chestnut Street, the same building that is home to Garth Fagan Dance.

Each room has one bed, a closet and a mini fridge. There is a lounge that has a microwave and a TV. There are no kitchen facilities available. (One option would be to ask a student or company member for use of their kitchen.) Coin-operated washers and dryers are also available and are located on the 8th floor. There is a change machine at the bus terminal across the street. You must bring your own linens (twin size) and your own towel.

You will receive a map and a list of restaurants, grocery shops and places of interest when you arrive. Students under 18 must be with an adult.

You can exit and enter the building anytime between 6:45 am and 9:00 pm Monday – Friday, and on Saturdays from 8:30 am – 12:00 pm. On off-hours, entry is by an access code typed on the intercom. The dorm monitors and students over 18 are the only ones with the access code to get in from the street. Do not let **anyone** walk in the door behind you who does not know the code to get in. If you are under 18, and you need to leave and enter the building during off-hours, you must be accompanied by an adult or the dorm monitor, but please give the dorm monitors plenty of notice. Remember we are in the heart of downtown, and at night, the streets are deserted, with some desperate people walking around Please be alert and responsible, and walk with an adult at night. We will provide all students with an access code for entry into the **dorm** area. For security reasons, **please do not share these codes with anyone.**

It is important that you send us your arrival time so that someone can be there to meet you and give you your key.

The total cost of the rooms for the duration of The Summer Movement Institute is \$450. All students must turn in their keys to the Dorm Monitor, or Natalie Rogers-Cropper. The Dorm Monitor will hand them over to The School Director before leaving.

The tenants that share the floor with you have complained in the past of doors slamming, loud talking, music playing, and practicing in the corridors. Remember that there are tenants other than yourselves that live there, and some do use the shared bathrooms. Men please avoid crossing over to the women's side and women, avoid crossing over to the men's side. Use discretion. The last thing the tenants want to see is a member of the opposite sex catching them coming out of the shower. The lounge is the best place for male/female socializing.

Please close your doors when socializing and keep your music low. Do not chat in the hallway, but if you must, please keep your voices down.
